On the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> of February 2019 the Department of Economics and Finance of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore (Italy) will host in Rome the X meeting of the Network on Economics of Regulation and Institutions (NERI).

NERI deals with the economics of regulation, meant in its broadest sense of public intervention aimed at affecting market outcomes, with particular attention to the relationship between regulatory tools and institutions.

This year's workshop will include an invited session on regulation of healthcare markets. **Pau Olivella** (Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona) and **Odd Rune Straume** (University of Minho) have already confirmed their participation.

### **Submissions**

We invite the submission of papers dealing with all the themes included in the interests of NERI. Since the focus of this year's workshop on healthcare markets, we especially encourage the submission of papers on this theme. ### **Registration fee and other expenses**
