



XIII NERI Workshop

On the **26**th **and 27**th **of May 2023** the Department of Economics and Finance of the University of Bari "Aldo Moro," in collaboration with the Department of Economics, Social Studies, Applied Mathematics and Statistics of the University of Torino, will host in Bari (Italy) the XIII meeting of the Network on Economics of Regulation and Institutions (NERI):

THE POLITICAL ECONOMICS OF REFORMS

NERI meetings focus on the economics of regulation, meant in its broadest sense of public intervention aimed at affecting market outcomes, with particular attention to the relationship between regulatory tools and institutions. This year's workshop will include two invited sessions, hosting each a key-note speaker: **Massimo Morelli** (Bocconi University, Director of Pericles) and **Claudio De Vincenti** (Sapienza University of Rome, LUISS School of European Political Economy) have kindly confirmed their participation.

Submissions

We invite the submission of papers dealing with all the themes included in the interests of NERI. As the focus of this year's workshop is on the *political economics of reforms*, we especially encourage the submission of papers on this theme. Registration fee and other expenses

The registration fee is 130 euros; it is inclusive of lunch, coffee breaks and a social dinner. On a discretionary basis, the organizing committee may grant partial exemptions, upon request, to students and junior fellows (PhD students, post-docs etc.) facing financial difficulties.
